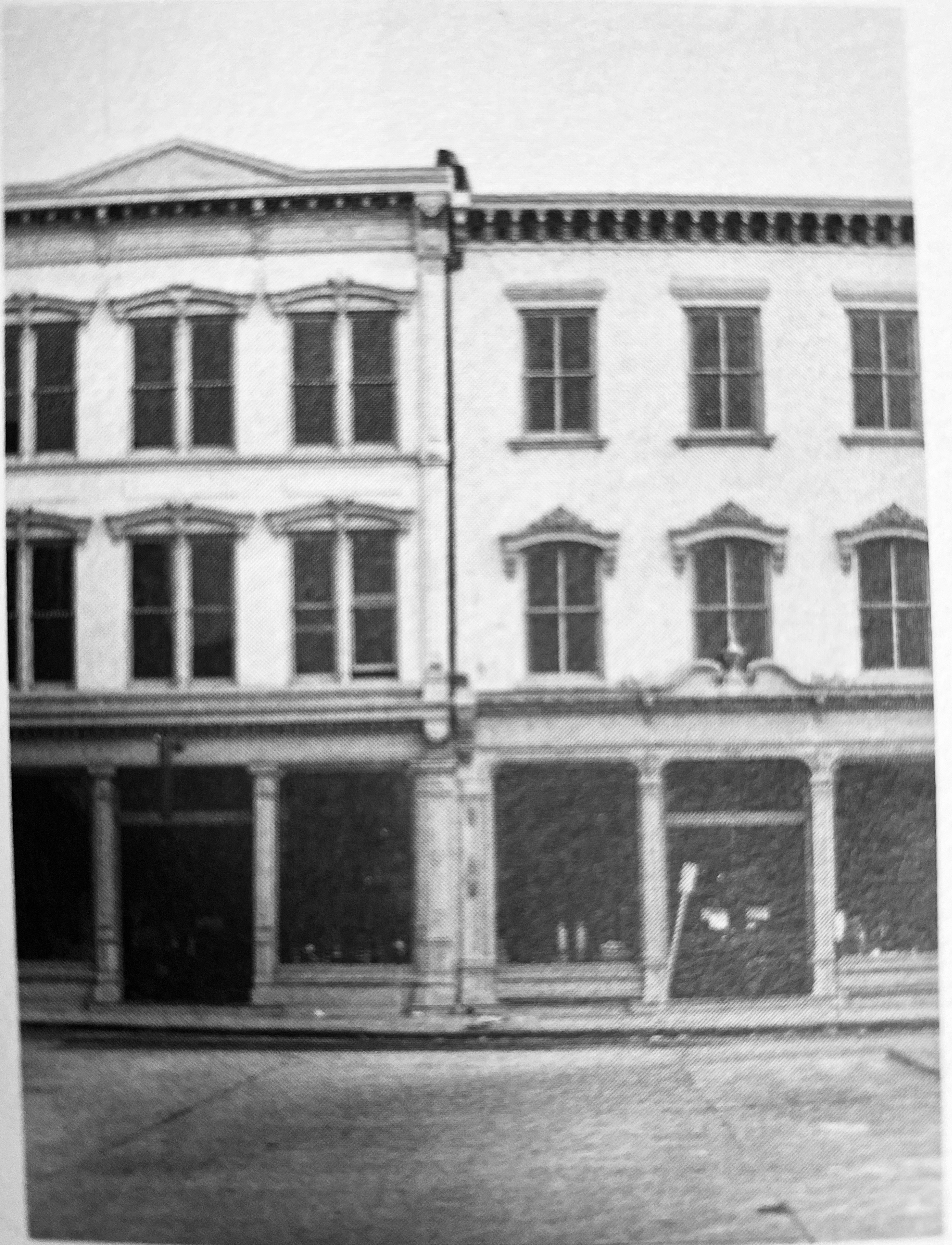

The large, elaborate neon fish sign hangs over the entrance to Frank C. Mathews fish and seafood store at 116 West Congress Street. Frank C. Mathews began his seafood business in the 1890s, originally dealing out of the City Market. Mathews moved the shop to 116 West Congress in the 1950s. A name once synonymous with Savannah seafood, Frank C. Mathews closed in 1995. The sign survives, restored with the title of another business. (Historic Savannah Foundation.)
