There should have been a traffic study done on Bull Street. Traffic will be a major problem for the community considering the proposed project will be adding a three story, market rate rent, 60 apartment complexes to the already congested traffic problem that exist on Bull Street and the streets in our neighborhood.

This is not the only proposed apartment on Bull Street. You have the 200 plus apartments behind the JEA, as well as the others near Victory Drive and the Fairgrounds.
