## CONSENT ORDER REGARDING PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR TEMPORARY

## RESTRAINING ORDER

This matter coming before the Court on Plaintiff's motion pursuant to O.C.G.A.§ 9-11-65(b) for a temporary restraining order and injunction against Defendants in this action, the Parties, by and through their respective counsel hereby consent as follows:

Defendants are permitted to install pay for parking signs with QR codes that may include towing language. Defendants agree not to install any sort of barricade, gate, or other structure of any type or that would block Plaintiff's access to any portion of the subject easement area or Plaintiff's ability to park vehicles within the easement without paying any type of fee to Defendants. Defendants agree not to tow vehicles from the easement area or otherwise interfere with Plaintiff's free ingress and egress over the entire easement area. This Consent Order will remain in place until such time as the Court has held a final hearing on Plaintiff's claim. By entering into this Consent Order, Defendants do not waive any defense or claim that they may have in this action nor do they acquiesce or consent to Plaintiff's use of the easement area for parking on a continuing basis. Nothing in this Consent Order shall be construed as a continuation of any claim that Plaintiff may have to the area by adverse possession. Defendants' prior notice to Plaintiff that use of the easement area for parking is prohibited remains in effect.

Pursuant to OCGA §9-11-65(a)(2), the Parties have consented to consolidate the hearing of the application for interlocutory injunction with the trial on the merits. A final hearing is hereby scheduled for <u>September 19, 2024</u>  $\otimes$  1:30 gm Courtroom 4B
