I wanted to make you aware of an article that was just posted by the Current that describes the City of Savannah's actions to refuse wastewater (sewer) from the Hyundai plant last fall due to high levels of certain elements found in the wastewater. The ceasing of service was done in line with state regulations and we have remained in conversation with Bryan County and Hyundai as they work to bring their wastewater into compliance.
