

Board Update – October 2025

- The job vacancy announcement was posted today, Thursday. [Job Opportunities | Chatham County, GA Government Careers](#)
- We will process absentee by mail ballots on Monday and Tuesday, November 3 and 4.
- We will use four check-in sites on election night – Rothwell Church, Ralph Mark Gilbert, The Election Annex, and the Election Office.
- We will use 11 election day technicians.
- The precertification zoom Board meeting will be Friday November 7th at 12 Noon.
- The Board of Elections regular meeting on Monday November 10th will include the certification of the November 4th election.
- The elections office will be closed on Tuesday November 11th in observance of Veterans Day.
- The Risk Limiting Audit (RLA) will be Friday November 14th at 11 AM.

Collocated precincts for November include:

- Voters in Precincts 1-6, Central Church on Stevenson, and 1-08, Grace Church on Waters, will vote in precinct 1-06 at the Central Church.
- Voters in Precincts 1-13, Sanctuary Church, and 1-14, St. Lukes Church, will vote in Precinct 1-13 at The Sanctuary Church.
- Voters in Precincts 3-09, Connexion Church, and 3-11, Southside Baptist Church, will vote in Precinct 3-09, at the Connexion

Church. We did not use Southside Church in June or July. They have expressed the desire to no longer serve as a polling place.

- Voters in Precincts 7-16 and 7-17 have both voted at the Pooler Rec Center for the past year and a half.
- Voters in Precincts 8-01, RMG Civil Rights Museum, and 8-05, May St YMCA, will vote in Precinct 8-01, at the RMG Civil Rights Museum.

The November ballot will include:

Bloomington – Mayor & City Council at Large – vote for 6

Garden City - City Council At Large & District 1 and 5

Port Wentworth – Mayor & City Council at Large & District 1 & 3

Thunderbolt – Mayor and Council At Large – vote for 6

Tybee Island - City Council At Large – vote for 3

Vernonburg – all races uncontested – no election required
