Chatham County Commission to Postpone Vote on STVR Ordinance Changes Following Community Input

For Immediate Release

Chatham County, GA (May 20, 2026) - After significant community input regarding proposed changes to Chatham County's Short-Term Vacation Rental (STVR) ordinance, Chatham County Chairman Chester A. Ellis will ask the commissioners to vote to table the Second Reading of the STVR Ordinance originally scheduled for Friday, May 22, 2026. This item will be taken up at a later date after the County Commissioners hold a workshop to discuss the recommended ordinance changes.

This action follows two productive community meetings on the STVR Ordinance. The Chairman and Commissioners have determined that a workshop would be beneficial to better understand the community's concerns and the impacts of the proposed changes, which now extend beyond the original scope of the agenda item. By gathering more information in a workshop setting, the Board can ensure that all changes to STVR Ordinance can be made at once.

The workshop on the STVR Ordinance will be scheduled for a later date. No action will be taken to amend or otherwise change the STVR Ordinance at the May 22 meeting of Chatham County Commission.
