Ret,

Thank you for taking the time to meet with me onsite to look at the work going on next to Grayson Stadium. As mentioned this morning, the grading that is taking place has already caused significant root damage to the live oaks along the road. I will spend some time tomorrow morning looking for the approved construction and grading plans to get a better idea of the project. I will also begin to develop a mitigation plan to try to give these trees a chance at survival. For there to be no type of tree protection on a project such as this is simply something that is not allowed.

In the meantime, there is to be no construction activity underneath the canopy of these trees except for the entrance on the south end as noted in the drawing below. This includes grading of any kind or moving of dirt. Please make sure that all of your contractors are aware to avoid any more issues while we come up with a plan to move forward.
